Mesh Networks

During the Bloomington ARA meeting, club president, Matt Holden (KØBBC), played this March, 2015, AREDN.org (Amateur Radio Emergency Data Network) video presentation by Andre Hansen (K6AH) on "mesh networks" https://www.youtube.com/watch?feature=player_embedded&v=fkl5Nbnz24Y It may interest ARES and RACES practitioners (*c.f.* with this guy's YouTube video screed: "Emcomm / ARES is a waste").

Evidently, not only is the AREDN TCP/IP software free, but it integrates seamlessly with any web browsers and email/messaging clients. It's actually flashable firmware for the antenna, which connects to the computer like an outboard WIFI antenna. Also, the antennas purportedly have reasonably powerful gain (i.e., for their class and application) (especially the "Ubiquiti" brand hardware). They're also cheap; ~\$100.00.

Encryption

There was a discussion that there is commercially-available, microwave-band, FCC-Part-15 equipment for transmitting encrypted EmComm of HIPAA-sensitive information through these AREDN mesh nodes (which connect to the internet). Apparently, Part 97 frowns on using cipher encryption keys that are not publicly known.

CryptoData is an easy-to-use, easy-to-install, rock-solid data encryption add-on for Mozilla-based clients (Firefox, Thunderbird and Seamonkey). See the screen shots and examples. Only install it through your Mozilla-based "Add on's Manager". If anyone's interested, email me for more detailed instructions. de Terry KEØDMZ
